

Academic Learning Platforms and Homework

EYFS and Pre-Prep (nursery – Year 2)

We use the Seesaw Family App (<u>https://web.seesaw.me/platforms-parents</u>) via which you will be able to view your child's online Journal, receiving notifications when new observations or videos are added and receive announcements from the Key Worker or Form Teacher. Staff will capture key milestones and learning opportunities through photos and videos, both of individual work and group activities.

Prep (Year 3 – Year 6)

We use Learning Ladders at Home (<u>https://www.learningladders.info/product-videos/ladders-at-home/</u>) so parents can have information on exactly what their child is learning in school, and how to help guide learning at home. This will include learning goals for each subject.

<u>Homework</u>

All pupils in Years 3-6 will follow the same homework timetable. Homework will be set for all pupils, but it will be optional (parental guidance) whether it is completed. All children should also read for at least 10minutes each day.

Children who are in Prep Aftercare 4.15-5pm will complete it in school under supervision of school staff. Pupils have access to a range of online platforms, including Atom Learning, that has a range of resources supporting 11+. In addition, from Year 3, children have non-verbal and verbal reasoning sessions as part of their Hallfield Enrichment rotations.
